He occurs also in 1740, the last list before that part of Somerset became Worcester Co MD. Episcopalian church record of his marriage and births of three children indicates that the family was Episcopalian. He served as a sergeant in Capt. Adam Spence's Co of "Somerset" county Militia in 1748.

It is not known when he moved his family to Lancaster County, SC but W. Jay Nelson states: James, Daniel, William, Robert and other Nelsons entered land in SC away back-- 1774-1790TM Robert appears in Lancaster Co. as early as 1772, as shown by land survey records.

### Notes for Mary Elizabeth Milbourne:

Mary Elizabeth Milbourne, oldest of the seven known children of Thomas (d1774) and Deborah Milbourne, was born in Somerset Co Maryland, later Worcester Co and moved with her husband, Robert Nelson, to Lancaster Co South Carolina, where she is buried at the Shiloh Church Cemetery.

### Epitaph at Shiloh Cemetery, Lancaster Co SC

"In memory of Elizabeth Nelson, wife of Robert Nelson, Esqr., who died April the 18th, 1818 in the 95th year of her age. A loving wife, a tender mother and a kind neighbor."

Notes on Amos Parker received from Darlene P. Smith, March 28, 1998:

Amos and his family left Union Co., NC in the early 1890's & moved to Georgia. He owned over 700 acres of land and ran a saw mill business. He sawed the lumber and donated it for the Methodist Church he attended. His grandson, Albert Miller Parker, remembers him as a "good man and a hard worker." Albert used to sit with Amos (his grandfather) in church. Amos later had heart trouble and died at home. Amos and Margaret were living in the Buford township in the Union Co., NC Census in 1880. The 1900 Census had him living in the Reidsville area in Tattnall Co., GA as a lumber manufacturer. In the 1920 Census, he is listed in Evans Co., GA and was living in Claxton, on Spring Street and was a saw mill operator. The 13 Aug 1908 issue of "The Tattnall Journal" (GA) stated that Amos owned the Parker Springs area at the time of its development and his home, sawmill, planing mill and store were located nearby. Recreation facilities there included a pavilion, camphouses and boats. Singing, dancing, boatriding, swimming, hiking and picnicking were popular pasttimes. School groups & political rallies were accomodated there. The 22 July 1909 issue of The Tattnall Times carried the following announcement by R. Norman: "I am now bringing the water from Parker Springs. Anyone wishing it will please notify me. 1 gallon a week, delivered every morning 25 cents, 2 gallons 35 cents." Flooding from high water made access roads impassable and Spring facilities unusable. For those reasons, and perhaps others, interest in local springs waned in the 1930's. In a history of the Claxton First Methodist Church in Georgia, we read: "In 1892 J.M. Bradley of Liberty County and A.C. Parker of NC moved to Claxton. They immediately began a prayer meeting. The following year a Sunday School was organized. In 1894, a church was organized with 25 members... Tattnall records show that land for the church was purchased from W.R. Hendricks for \$50 and that the deed was made to trustees Amos Parker" [& four others]. In 1912...the building committee was composed of A. C. Parker, M. S. Parker [and five others]. W. F. Freeman gave the bell which for many years called the people to worship on Sunday mornings. Memorial stained glass windows there bear the names of A. C. Parker, M. S. Parker" & others. Amos was among those known for long and faithful service in the church. The church later burned but was rebuilt. Amos and his wife are buried at Brewton Cemetery.

#### Other notes:

Friday, April 11, 1890, from THE CHARLOTTE DEMOCRAT (Mecklenburg County, NC) -Some one (sic) set fire to the barn of Amos C. PARKER, of Buford township, last night. All the contents, which were two tons of fertilizer, a wagon or two, and a considerable amount of corn, fodder, etc., were entirely consumed.

THURSDAY, April 24, 1890, from MONROE ENQUIRER AND EXPRESS (Union County, NC) -Mr. Amos PARKER has sold his farm, consisting of about 300 acres, lying in Buford township... Mr. Parker will go west.

Phifer and his heirs, a tract of land in Union County, State of North Carolina, on the waters of Lanes Creek, adjoining the Land of H [illegible word] Houston E D. Smith and J. J. Davis & C. Deese and others, bounded as follows, viz.: 1st Track beginning at an over [illegible] Tree on the North bank of Lanes Creek and runs N 3 E 11 chas & 80 links to a stake in a Branch Thence up the various course of said branch 26 50/100 chas to a P.O. on the East side of said Branch Thence N 54 E. 36 chas & 10 Links to a stake Thence N 32 E 40 chas & 50 Links to a B.J. & Thence with Davis line S.E. about 11 chas to a bunch W.O Thence S 5 W 24 chas to W O. (dead) Thence S 5 E 50 chas to a Persimmon on the bank of Lanes Creek. Thence with the various courses of 2d creek to the beginning containing one hundred & Fifty acres more or less. 2nd Tract Beginning on a Post oak on the Bank of a gravel Branch 2 P.O. & a Pine Pointers supposed to be (illegible) corner & runs with his lines W 35 E 6 chas & 50 links to his other corner on a P.O. Thence W 29 E 41 chas & 50 links to a White O. 2. Red O & Dogwood Pointers Thence N 20 W 18 chas to a stake with P.O. Hickory & B Jack Pointers supposed to be Anderson's corner. Zachariah and Mary Jane lived in Monroe, N.C. Prior to 1893, Zachariah went to Reidsville, GA. and purchased a farm and a big two story dwelling, where the present "Nelson Hotel" now stands. His oldest son Joesph and Daisy, his wife, and his daughter Lula, ran the dwelling as a "rooming house". Joseph and family, along with Lula were visiting the farm one Sunday, and the rooming house mysteriously burned. This house was purchased from a Mr. Folsom, who at that time was believed to have owned the "Tattnall Journal". The day that the structure burned, someone was seen crawling under the steps of the rooming house, and it was on that day that the house burned, and apparently was deliberately set on fire. An insurance company paid Zachariah for the damages, and he and two or three of this sons rebuilt the rooming house, and made it even larger to accommodate more roomers and boarders. Zachariah then named it "The Nelson Hotel", in honor of his wife, Mary Jane Nelson. Robert Nelson and his wife Katie ran the hotel for several years. After Robert died, his daughter, Blanche Nelson Sperry ran the hotel for another number of years.

In a conversation with Jerry Walker, after the 1997 Reunion, he told us that he had purchased the Hotel about seven years ago from the bank that was in the process of repossession. The bank intended to demolish it, and Jerry said that he and his wife could not stand to see such a beautiful

old structure destroyed. The Walkers purchased it and live there while remodeling it to it's present form, a "Bed and Breakfast Inn". They are now attempting to have it listed on the "National Register of Historic Places". It still remains the "Nelson Hotel", (and the Walkers residence).

The store was on Mint St. He and Blanche had alternated between living in Charlotte and Indian Trail, NC. Harvey was a Methodist. He frequently wore a round, black hat. In the 1900 Census of Tattnall Co., GA, Harvey was living in Reidsville as a lumber manufacturer, working at his father's saw mill. By 1910, he had moved back to Charlotte in ecklenburg Co., NC and was living on Graham St. as a General merchandise merchant.

In the 1920 Census, he had moved to Union Co., NC, living on Davis Gold Mine Road, in Vance township. By then he was a farmer. He had gone to college at Rutherfordton, NC. He loved to travel and went to New York several imes to visit. Blanche was a "homebody" and didn't accompany him.

Harvey's granddaughter, Shirley Haywood Taylor, related some of her memories of Harvey and Blanche and their home. Shirley wrote: "...we used to have great family "occasions" when we would all get together and have great times. Mostly at Christmas or Thanksgiving, etc. at grandmother's big old house on Mint Street in Charlotte. They would set a huge table in the dining room and the adults would eat first and we would all play on the big front porch that wrapped around the house, with huge windows almost down to the floor, so we could see them all in ther eating, before we could get at it. Or if it was cold (at Christmas) we would get the treat of playing in the "Parlor." It was very stiff and formal in the manner of that day, with a huge fireplace and Victorian mantle up to the ceiling. The sofa and chairs were hard and stiff and covered with something like horsehair which had stiff bristles and scratched when you sat on it. But we could explore the photographs, and the old piano, and the old black-page photograph albums. When we finally got to the table there would still be plenty to eat, with fried chicken and potato salad, and all kinds of vegetables, and grandmother's biscuits which I have NEVER been able to duplicate. They had a taste like no other, and she didn't cut them, but molded them in her hand and they were as big as your palm.

Nothing was better on a late Sunday afternoon, while visiting, than to get one of those biscuits with a chicken thigh in it. My sister would whisper in Grandma's ear asking if she had any sweet potato pie which was Billie's favorite. So then grandma would take us to the kitchen and up in the wooden cabinets would be all kinds of good things left from dinner...and before you left at night, Grandpa would take you into the store, (there was a doorway cut from their little bedroom and the back wall of the store.) It was a small little neighborhood grocery, but it held treasures for us...and grandpa would let us pick a couple of big cookies from out of the big glass jars with hinged lids."

Harvey died in a hospital following a two day stay. The death certificate says he suffered from "complete heart block". He served on the Governor's Board of Charlotte from 1915-1917. An article and picture appeared in the Charlotte Sun in the 29 May 1955 edition that included him. His obituary appeared in The Charlotte News on 24 April 1946. It read: "H.M. Parker Dies In City: Well Known Merchant Succumbs in Local Hospital After Illness Of Few Days...H.M. Parker of 1220 South Mint Street died in a local hospital yesterday afternoon at 2:15 o'clock after a few days illness. Mr. Parker had been in declining health for about two years. He had lived in Charlotte and

was a well known merchant here for 40 years..." His funeral service was held at Shiloh True Light Church in Mint Hill where he was buried next to his wife. He was living at 1220 South Mint Street at the time of his death.

At one time, Harvey was in business with the man who started the current chain of Belk Department Stores. Harvey's wife, Blanche had an Uncle Moses Walters. Moses was married to one of the daughters of James Belk. Harvey's daughter, Ruth, "always said that Grandpa said that he was Scotch-Irish - and that was the sum total of what anyone knew!"

Blanche's obituary appeared in the Charlotte Observer 27 Nov 1966. Her funeral was held at Shiloh True Light Church where she was buried. Her death certificate states she died of multiple heart failure in Hillcrest Manor, with contributing factors "old fracture of hip and humerus." She was 93 years old when she died.

Her husband adored her and "whatever Blanchie wanted, Blanchie got!" Her daughter, Vivian, used to take her out for her favorites - an orange soda & a Moon Pie! Vivian took care of Blanche in her old age. When Blanche was about 83 she was diagnosed with some rare, fast-growing cancer in between the wall of her stomach. They could feel the large lump, and the doctors gave her about six months to live. The cancer disappeared and she lived another ten years.

One of Blanche's favorite things to eat was hot dogs. Vivian took her to a Howard Johnson's restaurant once, hoping Blanche would order something besides a hot dog! As Vivian got through giving the waiter the order, she looked over at Blanche, who was grinning from ear to ear... and her teeth were sitting on the corner of the table, right by the water glass!

Blanche was very old-fashioned and shy. When her husband needed to travel out-of-state, she would not accompany him. She was an avid homebody. She was said to walk with both feet turned out and she took tiny little steps!

Even though Blanche was a shy woman, she loved to have her picture made, and she had lots of them in her old house. Back then they had to tint pictures with watercolors to have a color photo. One of the portraits in the old parlor had her with blue eyes. She loved it - though her eyes were brown!

Blanche's granddaughter, Shirley Haywood Taylor recalls about Blanche: "She could make the most delicious cakes I have ever had anywhere. She made the layers only half as thick as normal, so there would be seven or eight layers, all filled with chocolate, or coconut and sevenminute frosting, or pineapple. They were so moist they were almost wet and so-o-o-o good! Grandma made her own sauerkraut. It was not

quite so sour as normal, a touch sweet, and had hot peppers in it. One of my biggest regrets was that my mother never got the recipies for all those goodies before Grandma's mind went. There were always many bowls of chow-chows and picalillis that Grandma or her sisters Sally and Virge might have made...

One time in the early forties, we had a family reunion at our house on Winter Street in Charlotte, and EVERYONE came. Grandma and Grandpa, Floyd and his wife Brunette, and children who were home on leave from being missionaries in Columbia, South America, (not Floyd, just Brunette and the two children), Dwight and Margaret with Marilyn, Bunk and D.L., Walter and Thelma, and all their children, Vivian and Jack and Jackie, Vera and Hampton with Donald and Jewel, H.M. and Vernalee with Larry who was just a baby. There were around thirty people, and they were eating everywhere. I can remember the tall ones eating on mantles and some short ones even eating on a garbage can.

It must have been Thanksgiving, because mother had to cook the turkey 7 and a half hours which was normal in those days before tender turkeys..."

Shirley continues: "...she wouldn't go to church with him [Harvey] either. She belonged to a sect called The Truelites, or Truelights. They were branched off the Mennonites who were branched off the Amish. When I was about 10 or 11, for some reason I stayed the weekend with them and I went to church with them on Sunday down below Mint Hill, out in the country...and I was surprised to find that the women sat on one side and the men on the other. The men of the congregation took turns preaching on Sunday, and the Sunday we went, Uncle Josh Arant, her brother preached. You staved all day. Preaching all morning, then dinner on the grounds, and some more preaching in the afternoon. They had some of the attributes of the Amish...I remember that the women wore plain white shirts buttoned up to the collar and no neckties ... '

Blanche's grandson, Jerry H. Parker, relates that his mother (Hazel Harrison Parker) confirmed that Blanche was a good cook and Hazel was always in competition with her with to try to cook as good. Jerry writes: "She [Jerry's mother] said several of grandma's delicious dishes were macaroni and cheese, chicken and dumplings and egg custard. Mother said she tried to make them as good as grandma's and especially the egg custard: since dad was running a grocery store she said she would bake the custard and if it didn't measure up she would throw it out and go back to the store and get more supplies and try again - until she got it right."

Jerry continues, "I remember grandma's chicken and dumplings which were delicious. I think the

thing I remember more were her hot biscuits though... I always enjoyed eating at grandma's house... I spent quite a bit of time at the 1224 South Mint Street home of grandma and grandpa. I guess the thing that sticks out in my mind was the old refrigerator they had... It was about four or five foot high (the main box) but on the top of it were the big round coils. The refrigerator sat right outside the kitchen in the hall, as I remember. There was no TV when I was there but a big old fashioned radio...

A couple of the pieces of furniture I remember very well since I have them in my home now. Dad had them when he died... I have an old hand wind Victrola, including a few 78 rpm records and a drop leaf desk.

Grandpa was short, bald headed and wore glasses. He talked with a little rasp in his voice... I do remember he always prayed at every meal and his prayer was the same each time. I thought I'd always remember the words, but time has erased them."

Esther also had a dry goods store in Reidsville for a number of years, before selling it and moving to Florida.

Albert Parker owned and operated the bakery in Claxton, Georgia that produced Claxton Fruit Cakes.

From the Claxton Fruitcake Co, website:

In 1945, Savino Tos decided to retire from his Claxton bakery and devote his time to other business interests. Having fostered a trusting relationship with young Albert Parker through the years, Tos sold the Claxton Bakery to his long-time employee.

After Albert Parker's acquisition of the bakery, he began to search for other means of growth. During the mid-1940's, in the era following World War II, Parker recognized that many traditional bakery items were suddenly being marketed in businesses other than bakeries. Racks filled with fresh loaves of bread appeared in grocery stores. Refrigerated cases containing ice cream and soft drinks were beginning to be commonly found in service stations. These revelations led Albert Parker to make a bold decision. His bakery would specialize in high quality fruit cake, a product of unique originality enjoyed by the townspeople during the fall holiday season.

In his first year of mass production, Parker and a handful of workers baked forty-five thousand pounds of Claxton Fruit Cake. The new owner worked diligently in his efforts to develop sales and distribution for his cakes. As the number of sales outlets increased, Parker's operations expanded. People from all parts of the country began to talk about "those delicious fruit cakes with the unique horse and buggy label."

In the early-1950's, Parker was visited by a representative of the Civitan Club of Tampa, Florida. The civic club was in search of a fund-raising item, and Claxton Fruit Cake seemed to be the perfect choice. As a result of their initial success selling Claxton Fruit Cakes as a fund-raiser, the Tampa Civitans spread the word to their colleagues in other clubs. As each year passed, more and more groups discovered the sales appeal of Albert Parker's famous fruit cakes.

Today, the Claxton Bakery, Inc. services the fund-raising needs of over one-thousand organizations throughout North America. Claxton Fruit Cakes are also available through many national chains during the holiday season.

Albert Parker continued his operation of Claxton Bakery, Inc., until his passing on May 21, 1995. The bakery is presently managed by Parker's three sons, Mid, Paul and Dale, and his daughter, Betty. The company's hallmarks of quality, value and service continue to guide the Parker family's commitment to their customers around the world.

Daniel (DD) grew up in Claxton at 6 N. Grady Street. A warehouse belonging to Claxton Fruitcake Co. (his 1st cousin Albert's business) now stands where the house once stood. DD left Claxton for 30 days of Civilian Military Training Camp at Ft. Moultrie, near Charleston, SC, in the summer of 1929--He said it was "Worse than boot camp on Paris Island." About 1932, the family temporily moved to Beaufort, SC, where he found work with the Highway Department doing road maintenance. He later enrolled (4 months) in the Civilian Conservation Corps and camped near Jacksonboro, SC. He then went to work for Harold Keyserling as a tank wagon salesman driving a Stardard Oil truck and, about 1938 joined the South Carolina National Guard. !Walter always went by "Al". He was very active and loved to fix & build things. He had a crazy sense of humor! Shortly after his marriage he served active duty in the Navy.

He worked for Ellis-Stone in Durham and a friend, Oscar "Buddy" Durham wrote him about a good job opportunity at Davis Department Store in Winston-Salem, NC. He moved his wife and baby daughter there and worked for the company for the rest of his life. He was a store manager and was also a merchandising manager.

When he was working at the store branch in Thruway Shopping Center, he was robbed at gun point by two men. They tied him up with electrical cord and stuck him under his desk after forcing him to open the safe. He managed to work his hands free to call the police and he was unhurt, though pretty shaken! Fortunately, both men were caught and served prison terms.

Al was very handy around the house and enjoyed working on various projects. At his home at 226 Foxcroft Drive in Winston-Salem, NC, he made a built-in wall unit in the downstairs den for the TV, stereo, etc. He connected a speaker to the kitchen, so you could hear the record player in there also.

In the back yard of that same home, he made a brick patio/terrace of much of the back yard. He built a large screened-in "gazebo-type" building on the bricked in terrace. There was a dinette set in there with a barbeque grill and the family loved to cook out in there. It was great because the screen kept out the bugs. His children loved to play "house" in there.

He amazed the neigborhood children by

demonstrating cartwheels around the front yard! It was while living at this house that he taught his daughter how to ride her bike. He spent endless hours holding on to the seat of the bike, running up and down the road until Darlene got the hang of riding!

The family lived at this house for about five years. Greg was born while living at this house.

The family then moved to 6641 Grasmere Court in nearby Clemmons, NC. They bought the home in the early stages of construction, so Al and Phyllis were able to choose their colors, carpet and such. The family went over nearly every day to see what progress had been made. Later, Al built on a double-car garage, with Phyllis handing him up supplies. They fenced in the yard and did extensive landscaping. Al also built on a large deck. He also enjoyed making some of their furniture. It was at this house that Al became ill, to die 10 years later.




